

Botball Educational Robotics Program

Statistical Impact

Approximately 93,653 individuals including 40,280 students have been impacted by the Botball Program.

About 3,023 teachers have participated in Botball and attended the hands-on Professional Development Educator Workshops.

2,014 Botball kits have been distributed to students and teachers in schools and communities across the nation.

100% of teachers surveyed indicated that Botball was a valuable experience for their students.

90% of Botball teachers rated the technical content and presentation of the Professional Development Educator Workshops as good to excellent.

93% of students surveyed stated that Botball was one of the best or better things they've ever participated in at school.

89% of students feel more confident with technology after participating in Botball.

87% of the students participating in the International Botball Tournament feel comfortable reading and writing a basic computer program.

Just over one third of Botball students were undecided about their college careers, and after participating in Botball 100% of these students now plan to pursue a degree in a technical or math-related field.

About 2,000 students, teachers, parents, mentors, and sponsors have attended our National Conference on Educational Robotics over the past five years.

Botball is a national educational robotics program from KISS Institute for Practical Robotics, a non-profit organization. Middle school and high school aged students can participate in the program as part of a classroom activity, after-school program or club, or through a community based group.
